Know the signs

Check your breasts every month and look out for any of the following signs. Check regularly so you know what's usual for you. If anything doesn't seem right contact your GP practice.

Lumps or thickening in your breasts or armpits.

Discharge from your nipple.

Skin changes like puckering or dimples.

Itching or a rash or crust around your nipple.

Unexplained pain in your breast.

Change in the size or shape of your breast.

Skin irritation on your breasts.
